Schaumburg-Hoffman Lions Diamond Sponsor for Little Angles Pledge Run

The Schaumburg-Hoffman Lions club was a Diamond-Level sponsor of a successful fund raising event for the Little Angles Home for severely disabled children in Elgin Illinois. The club presented a check for \$4,500 to the Little Angles organization that represented funds raised in a Superbowl Sunday fund raiser held last February. In addition, the club provided 20 volunteers who aided in ticket sales, door prize distribution, and food service at the 2010 Motorcycle pledge run.

The 2010 Motorcycle pledge run was the 22nd annual run for benefit of the Little Angles home. Some 2,280 riders rode 1,500 motorcycles on an 80 mile run, followed by food, beverages, and entertainment at the grounds of Woodstock Harley Davidson in Woodstock IL.

The Lions club added to the entertainment with 10-foot LION Chris, who paced the grounds to the delight of riders and Little Angles residents who attended the event.

The Schaumburg-Hoffman Lion club has been active in support of the community for the past 49 years, and sponsors a weekly bingo game on Friday night at 6:45 pm the VFW Post 5151, 520 S. Bartlett Road in Streamwood IL.
