How does an individual become a Melvin Jones Fellow? There are several ways...

- When any individual, Lions club, or district donates \$1,000 to LCIF for a Melvin Jones Fellowship, an inscribed plaque and lapel pin are presented to the specified individual.
- Any individual, Lions club, or district may choose to donate unrestricted funds in increments of at least \$100, over a 5 year period. When contributions total \$1,000, an individual named by the donors becomes a Melvin Jones Fellow.
- For a gift of \$1,000, a Melvin Jones Fellowship may be given to honor the memory of a deceased individual.

What are Melvin Fellowship donations used for?

- To provide funding for constructing and equipping medical facilities.
- To support vocational assistance programs that teach skills to disabled persons.
- To help fund reconstruction projects following major disasters.
- They have been used to provide homes for children with special needs and homes for the elderly.
