ample of how one organization, with members working together, can sustain communities.

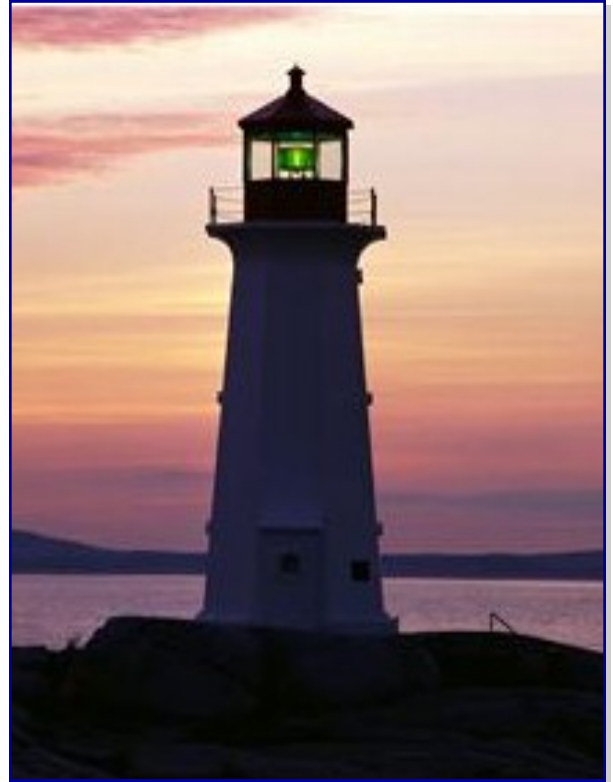
We are a beacon of hope for all the world to see.
